This Privacy Policy explains how Smet & Sanders Consulting LLC (“Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”), a Florida limited liability company, collects, uses, discloses, and protects personal information in connection with our websites (coachdaniellasanders.be, smetconstructionconsulting.com, collectively the “Websites”) and our online coaching and consulting services (“Services”), including educational coaching, tutoring, structural calculations, technical support, project management, and construction tutoring. We are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring compliance with applicable data protection laws, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for users in the European Union.

1. Scope of This Policy

1.1 Applicability

This Privacy Policy applies to personal information collected through the Websites and Services, whether you are an individual client, a representative of a company, or a visitor to our Websites.

1.2 Third-Party Platforms

We use third-party platforms (e.g., Calendly, Microsoft Teams, Google Meet, Zoom, WhatsApp, PayPal, Apple Pay) for scheduling, communication, and payments. These platforms have their own privacy policies, which govern their data practices. We are not responsible for their data handling practices.

1.3 No Storage of Customer Data

2. Information We Collect

2.1 Information You Provide

We may collect the following personal information directly from you when you engage our Services or interact with our Websites:

2.1.1 Contact Information: Name, email address, or phone number provided when scheduling sessions (e.g., via Calendly) or communicating with us.

2.1.2 Payment Information: Billing details processed through third-party payment providers (e.g., PayPal, Apple Pay, or bank transfer details) to facilitate payment for Services.



2.1.3 Service-Related Information: Information you provide for the delivery of Services, such as project specifications, educational needs, or other relevant details.

2.2 Information Collected Automatically

2.2.1 Our Websites may collect limited technical information, such as IP addresses, browser type, or device information, through cookies or similar technologies for basic functionality and analytics.

2.2.2 We do not use cookies or tracking technologies for advertising or profiling purposes.

2.3 Information from Third-Party Platforms

When you use third-party platforms (e.g., Calendly, Teams, Google Meet, Zoom, WhatsApp), they may collect personal information (e.g., scheduling preferences, video call metadata). Such data is subject to their respective privacy policies.

3. How We Use Your Information

3.1 Purpose of Use

We use your personal information solely for the following purposes:

3.1.2 To process payments through third-party payment providers.

3.2 No Marketing or Newsletters

4.2 Legal Compliance

4.3 No Sale of Data

We do not sell, rent, or share your personal information for marketing or advertising purposes.

5. Data Storage and Retention

5.1 No Long-Term Storage

We do not store your personal information after the completion of Services, except as required to comply with legal or accounting obligations (e.g., payment records for tax purposes).

5.2 Third-Party Platforms

5.3 Data Minimization

6.2.3 Lodge a Complaint: File a complaint with a supervisory authority in your country.
